

of the regiment, battalion or company, to which it is to be attached, having been first obtained.

No military Lodge to initiate an inhabitant, nor under the rank of a corporal.

2. No Military Lodge shall, on any pretence, initiate into masonry any inhabitant or sojourner in any town or place at which its members may be stationed, or through which they may be marching, nor any person who does not, at the time belong to the military profession, nor any military person below the rank of corporal, except as serving brethren, or by dispensation from the grand master.

Military Lodges.

3. Any Military Lodge in this Country, shall conduct itself conformably to the regulations of the Grand Lodge of Nova-Scotia.

If a regiment be disbanded the warrant to be transmitted to the Grand Lodge.

4. If the regiment, battalion or military body to which the Military Lodge is attached, be disbanded or reduced, the brethren shall take care that the warrant be carefully transmitted to the Grand Lodge, that it may not fall into improper hands; but, if a competent number of the brethren remain together, they may apply for another warrant, of the same number, to be holden as a civil Lodge, at such place as may be convenient, and which may be approved by the grand master.
