BY-LAW No. 890.

By-Law Authorizing the Levying and Collecting of a Sum of Money for County Purposes, for the year 1889.

Whereas it is necessary to levy and collect the sum of \$12,142.80 for County Purposes for the current year, 1889.

Be it therefore enacted a By-Law of the Corporation of the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry, that the sum of \$12,142.80 be levied and collected out of the whole rateable real and personal property of the said United Counties for County Purposes for the current year, in the proportions and sums set opposite the names of the several municipalities respectively as hereafter set out, being at the rate of three-quarters of a mill on the dollar, the assessed value of the said rateable property. That is to say:

BY-LAW No. 891.

By-Law Authorizing the Renewal of Certain Notes under Discount at the Bank of Montreal.

Whereas there are at present under discount at the Bank of Montreal three notes, that is to say, a note for \$15,000 for current expenditure; a note for \$11,000 for Nation River Drainage account, and a note for \$2,900.00 for River Beaudette Drainage account, and whereas these several notes may have to be renewed.

Be it enacted a By-Law of these United Counties, that the Warden and Treasurer be, and they are hereby authorized to renew the said notes with the Bank of Montreal as they may become due and payable, and until arrangements are made for the retiring of the whole or part of the said notes aforesaid.

BY-LAW No. 892.

By-Law Authorizing the Borrowing of Money for Current Expenditure.

Be it therefore enacted a By-Law of the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and

Glengarry, that the Warden and Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to borrow from some Chartered Bank of the Dominion, for the purpose above set forth, such sum or sums of money as may be necessary in the opinion of the Finance Committee, provided said sum or sums of money shall not exceed two thousand five hundred dollars; and shall execute for said sum or sums of money a note or notes under the seal of the Corporation, payable at such date or dates within the current year, and to pay the same out of the monies that may be levied and collected for County purposes.

BY-LAW No. 894.

By-Law to Grant Permission to the Corporation of the Township of Winchester to Assume and Lay Out Certain Streets in the Village of Morewood.

Whereas the Corporation of the Township of Winchester has petitioned for permission to assume and lay out certain streets in the Village of Morewood, of the width of forty feet, and it is expedient to grant permission.

Be it therefore enacted a By-Law of the Corporation of the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry, that the Corporation of the Township of Winchester have permission to assume and lay out two certain streets, as follows:—One running North and South through part of Lot Number Eighteen in the Eleventh Concession of the Township of Winchester, and described as follows: Commencing at the South-east corner post of a Village Lot deeded to William Moffatt, being part of the aforesaid Lot Number Eighteen; thence East
