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13. No printing or stationery should be charged for, but on requisition to the Department, the necessary articles for official use will be supplied, if approved.

14. The following maximum allowances have been decided upon, when travelling strictly on official business. The names of parties paid and their addresses must be given in each case.

Meals	25 cents
Horse hire	10 cents per mile.
Lodging (each night) ...	25 cents.
Baiting Horse	25 cents.

15. No *legal assistance* should be employed without the authority of this Department.

16. All travelling expenses, which are reasonable and actual, will be allowed. The Department will determine whether they are reasonable from the explanation given in support of the expenditure in the Overseer's diary. If in doubt as to the expediency of incurring travelling expenses, the advice and authority of the Department should be sought. No expenses incurred in hunting up parties guilty of damaging or stealing fish from fishermen's nets will be allowed.
