Calgary, April 5 .- According to figures compiled after a careful survey of the situation and a computation of grain in elevators, it is estimated that there is still approximately 25,000,000 bushels of wheat in the Province of bushels of wheat in the Province of Alberta, that Saskatchewan has approximately 35,000,000 bushels on hand, and that Manitoba has approximately 12,000,000 bushels. In Fort William and Port Arthur there is approximately 20,000,000 bushels, while in the rest of the Dominion there is approximately 10,000,000 bushels. The total for the Dominion, according to these figures, would be 102,000,000 bushels.
