LONG VACATION extends from the 1st of July to the 21st of August. In Chancery, there is also a vacation from the 24th December to the 6th January.

COUNTY COURT TERMS.—The several County Courts in Ontario hold four terms in each year, commencing respectively on the first Monday in the months of January, April, July and October, and ending on the Saturday of the same week.

Circuits of the Courts.

LAW CIRCUITS.—Courts of Assize and Nisi Prius and of Oyer and Terminer and General Jail Delivery are held twice a year in each County or union of Counties, in the vacation between Hilary and Easter Terms, and between that period of the vacation after the 21st of August and Michaelmas Term, except the Counties of York and Wentworth, in each of which Counties there is held a third such Court in every year, in the vacation between Michaelmas and Hilary Terms; and in the County of York there is held a fourth such Court, between Easter Term and the first day of July. The Courts of Assize and Nisi Prius may, in the discretion of the Judges, be held separate and apart from the Courts of Oyer and Terminer and General Jail Delivery, and the Assizes for any County are not put an end to by the commencement of Term, but may continue and be holden during Term, subject to special rules in such case for moving against the verdict or for new trials. There are eight Circuits, as follows, viz:—

Eastern: Cornwall, L'Orignal, Ottawa, Pembroke, Perth. *Midland:* Belleville, Brockville, Kingston, Napanee, Picton. *Victoria:* Brantford, Cobourg, Lindsay, Peterboro', Whitby. *Brook:* Goderich, Owen Sound, Stratford, Walkerton, Woodstock. *Niagara:* Cayuga, Hamilton, Milton, St. Catharines, Welland. *Waterloo:* Barrie, Berlin, Brantford, Guelph, Simcoe. *Western:* Chatham, London, Sandwich, Sarnia, St. Thomas. *Home:* Toronto.

The Courts in each Circuit shall be presided over by one of the Chief Justices or Judges of the Superior Courts, or of the Courts of Appeal or Chancery, or, in their absence, by a Judge of a County Court, or some one of Her Majesty's Counsel learned in the law, requested by anyone of the Chief Justices or Judges of the Superior Courts to act in that behalf.

CHANCERY CIRCUITS, for the Examination of Witnesses and Hearing Causes, are held in the Spring and Fall of each year as follows:—

Toronto: Toronto. *Eastern:* Belleville, Brockville, Cobourg, Cornwall, Kingston, Lindsay, Ottawa, Peterboro'. *Western:* Chatham, Goderich, London, Sandwich, Sarnia, Stratford, Walkerton, Woodstock. *Home:* Barrie, Brantford, Guelph, Hamilton, Owen Sound, Simcoe, St. Catharines, Whitby.

The Courts in each Circuit are presided over

by the Chancellor, or one of the Vice-Chancellors, or by a retired or present Judge of the Superior Courts of Law or of the Court of Appeal, or by a Judge of a County Court, or by some one of Her Majesty's Counsel learned in the law, requested by the Chancellor or one of the Vice-Chancellors to act in that behalf.

COMMISSIONERS FOR TAKING AFFIDAVITS.—These Commissioners may be classed under three headings. *First*—Commissioners in Ontario for taking affidavits to be used in Ontario under Consolidated Statutes of Upper Canada, 22 Vic. cap. 39. *Second*—Commissioners in Ontario for taking affidavits to be used in Quebec, and Commissioners in Quebec for taking affidavits to be used in Ontario, under consolidated Statutes of Canada, 22 Vic. cap. 79. *Third*—Commissioners in England, or any Colony or Dependency thereof, for taking affidavits to be used in Ontario under 34 Vic. cap. 14.
