GRID ZONE DESIGNATION	13 X
EXAMPLE: STREAM JUNCTION	
EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point	60
Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point	60.4
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point	01
Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point	01.1
MILITARY GRID REFERENCE	604011
Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 62 miles)
