THE ACTS AND PROCEEDINGS

OF THE

Fourteenth Synod

Of Manitoba and the North-West Territories

Held in Knox Church, Winnipeg, on the 10th, 11th, 12th and 13th Days of November, 1896.

FIRST SEDERUNT.

At Winnipeg, and within Knox Church there, on the 10th day of November, 1896, and at 8 o'clock in the evening.

At which time and place the Synod of Manitoba and the North-West Territories met.

The retiring Moderator, Rev. Alex. Matheson, conducted divine service, preaching a sermon based upon the 16th verse of the First Chapter of Romans:—"For I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God unto Salvation to every one that believeth, to the Jew first and also to the Greek."

The Clerk then called the Roll of Synod, marking those present with an asterisk. (See Appendix.)

The retiring Moderator intimated that his term of office had expired, and after thanking the Synod for the support given and the courtesy shown him during the Synodical year, requested Synod to proceed to the appointment of his successor.
