Purchase money may be invested in lands, rents, &c., which may be again sold.

III. It shall be lawful for the said community of the Sisters of Charity of the General Hospital of Montreal to purchase or acquire and hold at any time other immoveable property or constituted or ground rents charged upon real estate or immoveable property, up to the amount of the capital produced by the sale or alienation of the property which they are authorized to sell or alienate by this Act, and to sell or otherwise alienate at any time, in the manner prescribed by this Act, the real property, lands received in exchange, constituted or ground rents so acquired, the laws respecting mortmain or any other Act or law to the contrary notwithstanding.

Return of property sold, &c., to be made to the Governor when called for.

IV. The said community of the Sisters of Charity of the General Hospital of Montreal, shall, when required so to do by the Governor or person administering the government of this Province, make a report and submit to him a statement of the sales or other alienations, and of the acquisitions which they may have effected in virtue of this 15 Act, and of all sums of money which they have received as and for the principal arising from the sales or alienations which they shall have effected under the authority of this Act.

V. This Act shall be deemed to be a public Act.
