Ordered, That the Clerk do go down to the House of Commons and acquaint that House that the Senate have passed this Bill, to which they desire their concurrence.

The Honourable Mr. Boulton moved, That it will result in a benefit to the material and commercial interests of Canada, if we were to adopt the offer indicated by the Right Honourable Joseph Chamberlain, Colonial Secretary, for an Imperial Customs Union based on a free trade Zollverein.

After Debate,

The said motion was, by leave of the House, withdrawn.

Then, on motion of the Honourable Sir Mackenzie Bowell, seconded by the Honourable Mr. Ferguson (P.E.I.),

The Senate adjourned.
