

standing ; and to the end that nothing may be passed or done by Our said Legislative Council and Assembly to the prejudice of Us, Our Heirs, and Successors, We will and ordain that you shall have and enjoy a negative voice in the making and passing such Laws, Statutes, and Ordinances aforesaid, and that you shall and may, from time to time, as you shall judge it necessary, adjourn, prorogue, or dissolve all General Assemblies as aforesaid.

Governor to have negative voice in the passing of Statutes, also power to adjourn, prorogue, or dissolve Assembly.
