An Act in further amendment of the Dominion Elections Act.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

5 Lestion 7 of The Dominion Elections Act, chapter 8 of R.S.C., c. 8, the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto s. 7 amended the following paragraph:—

(h.) "Any person who is not a permanent resident of the municipality in which he would act as such election officer."

- 2. Section 22 of the said Act, as amended by section 2 of Section 22 chapter 19 of the statutes of 1891, is hereby amended by striking out all the words after the word "and" in the sixth line thereof, and also by striking out subsection 2 of the said section.
- 3. Section 30 of the said Act is amended by adding thereto Section 30 the following paragraph:—
- (f.) "And shall, at least two days before the day fixed for polling, furnish, upon request, to a candidate or his agent, a list of all deputy returning officers appointed to act in such election, with the name or number of the booth at which they 20 are to act."

4. Section 32 of the said Act is amended by adding after Section 32 the word "a" in the third line thereof the words "resident amended of the municipality as."

- 2. The said section is further amended by adding thereto 25 the following:—"Each deputy returning officer shall furnish to the returning officer, not later than twenty-four hours before the day fixed for polling, the name of such poll clerk; and the returning officer shall, at least twelve hours before the day fixed for polling, furnish, upon request, to a candidate or his 80 agent, the names of all poll clerks and the booths at which they are to act."
 - 5. Subsection 2 of section 33 of the said Act is amended by Section 33 adding after the word "a" in the third line thereof the fol-amended lowing words:—"resident of the municipality as."
- 85 6. Section 48 of the said Act is amended by adding thereto Section 48 the following:—" and imprisonment for at least six months, amended. with or without hard labour, or to both."
