An Act to authorise the Defendant in certain actions of damages to conclude in his defence, for contrainte par corps.

THEREAS it is expedient to place both parties to action of damages, Preamble. of a certain nature, on a footing of equality: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. In all actions of damages for personal wrongs, in which the Plaintiff personal 5 is entitled to contrainte par corps against the Defendant, after having first wrongs may have conconcluded therefor in his declaration, the Defendant shall be entitled, when trainte for the judgment in the case shall be in his favor, to contrainte par corps against the Plaintiff, (having previously concluded therefor in his defence,) for an amount of costs equal to the sum for which the Plaintiff may conclude for 10 such contrainte against the Defendant, under the Laws now in force.

II. This Act shall apply to Lower Canada only.
