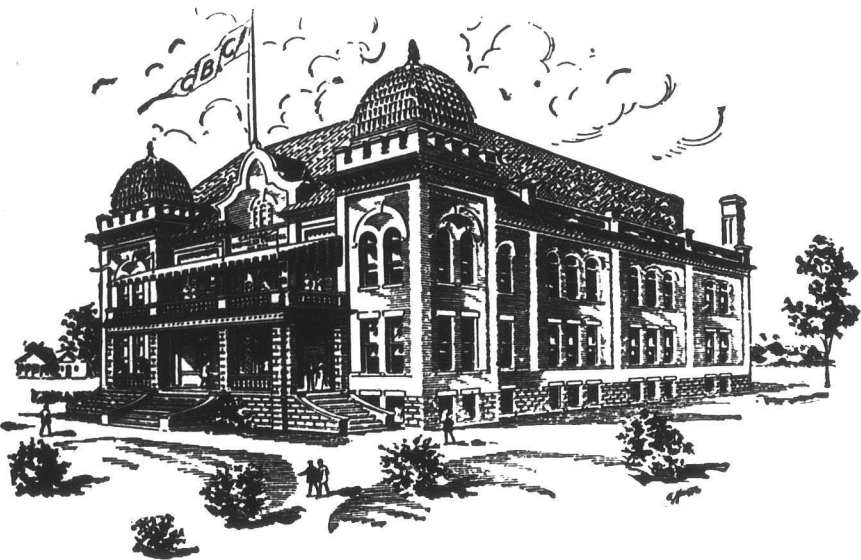


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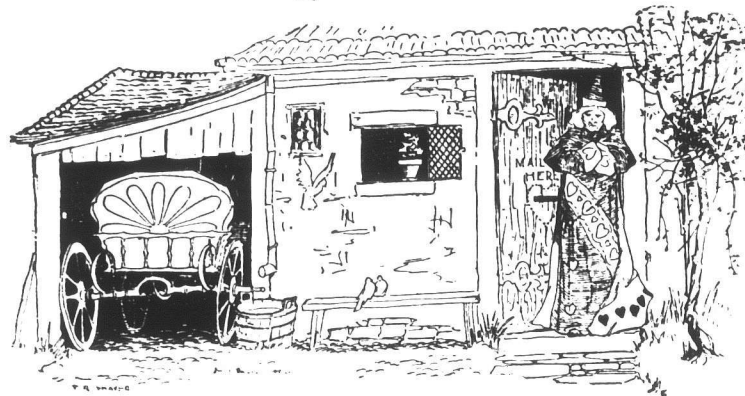
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The Saint's Progress

"I fear," sighed he, "'tis out of date!



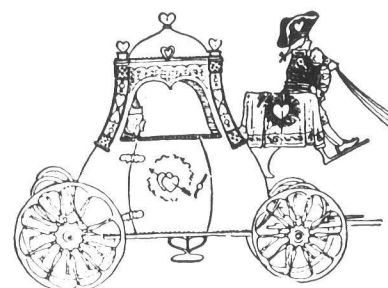
"When I was

To set me quicker on my way;

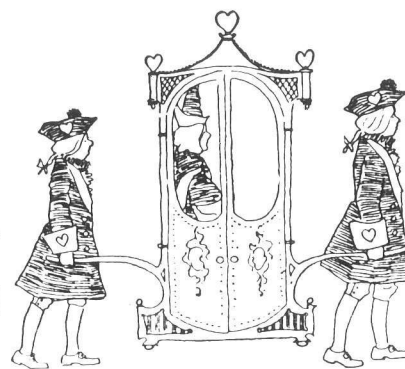


"Or rode among my
