## Guests escape fate of bird

A beautiful turkey dinner almost went up in smoke. Sun., Dec. 8.

Mrs. Josephine Lyons, 1534 Dundas Hwy. w., in Erindale, was entertaining guests at a pre-Christmas celebration, when her house filled with smoke and gave every indication of threatening to go up in flames.

A hurried call brought the Mississauga Fire Dept. screaming down only to find the cause

very minor. A log had fallen through the fireplace grating and caught fire on the slab below, causing enough flame and smoke to make Mrs. Lyons assume her floor was burning.

The stalwart firefighters removed the wood with the aid of a steel wash tub, windows and doors were left open to clean the air, and the party went on, although the turkey was cold.

## Landowners participate in reclaiming

A score of landowners in the Etobicoke Creek flood plain area have been asked by general committee if they want to help pay for a \$13 million scheme to reclaim private land for possible building purposes.

The landowners, who appeared before committee last week generally agreed in principle that they would support the scheme if it went ahead but also wanted to know just what part the town of Mississauga would play in it.

The flood control scheme involving the channeling of the Etobicoke Creek to prevent erosion and floods in heavy storm conditions, is proposed by Metro Toronto Conservation Authority.

The M. M. Dillon Report which sets out the engineering and cost-sharing aspects of the proposal, recommends that Mississauga pay about \$446,000 — two-thirds of the 50 percent total left after the Conservation Authority forks over the first half.

It recommends that Etobicoke pays the re-

maining third. Town council has argued against paying that amount on the basis that it would be spent improving private property and making it "buildable."

The scheme envisages a 65-foot-wide channel designed to carry a flood capacity of 14,400 cubic feet.

The channel would have ten-foot high banks, side slopes and rip-rap, intended to protect 89 acres of flood plain land from floods.

Using the Dillon Report if Mississauga was to pay at the suggested cost-sharing rate it would have to come up with two-thirds of \$700,000.
