Erindale appoints professors

Three senior academic posts have been filled at Erindale College, two of them by Mississauga residents.

Professor L.J. Brooks of Mississauga, will be the associate dean of the social sciences department at the University of Toronto satellite college for the next three years.

Professor Brooks has a Master of Business Administration degree from the University of Toronto and is a chartered accountant. He will teach one course on accounting literature and research at Erindale.

The new associated dean is vice-president of

the Canadian Academic Accounting Association and chairman of the treasury department of the United Church of Canada.

Another Mississauga resident, Professor R.W. Van Fossen, has been named vice-principal of academic affairs.

The PhD graduate from Harvard University has taught at Erindale since 1970. Professor Van Fossen is a director of the Mississauga Symphony and a trustee of the Shakespeare Association of America.

The new associate dean for sciences is Professor J.J. Fawcett.

A man who allegedly threw the glass suffered severe bruising to the face when the victim retaliated, police say.

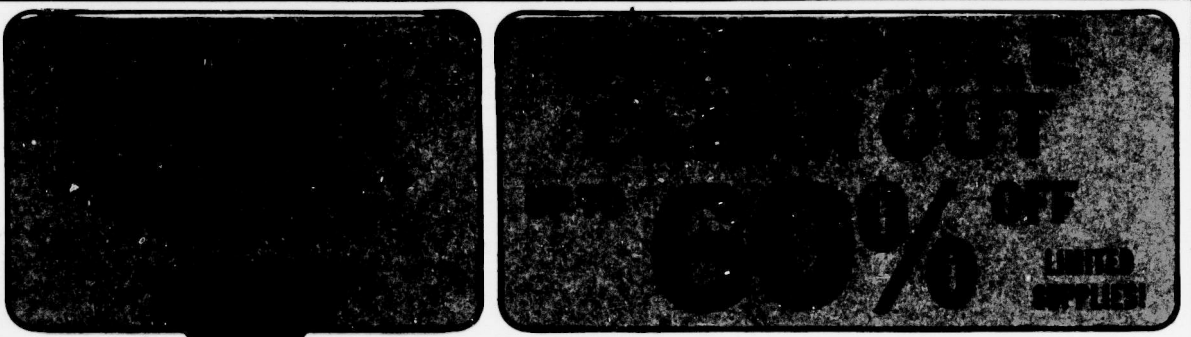

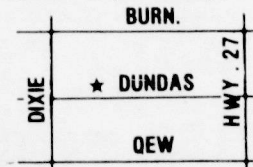
