	6 - 1 - 41		Light snow intermittently all day and night. Flying off and on all day. Night flying till 0400 hours.	
	7 - 1 - 41		First fine flying day in weeks, training going right ahead. Night flying till 0500 hours. F/O Gedge S.O.S. this station on posting to H. Q. No. 1 T.C.
