Uplands, Ontario	12 May 1943	(cont'd)	<p>Enrique Penaranda, President of Bolivia and representatives of his Government, visited the Station. He was received by the Minister of National Defense for Air, Hon. C.G. Power, Air Marshal Breadner, Air Vice-Marshal deRiverville and Sully, Group Captain Raymond, Group Captain West, and other officers from A.F.H.Q. and #3 Training Command. A Guard of Honour was inspected by the President after the salute to Bolivia by the Rockcliffe Band.</p> <p>R158698 Sgt Fawcett, W.J.E. with R159989 LAC Murray, D.H., as student, allowed aircraft to swing on landing, when pupil applied excessive rudder. Very slight damage to wing tip. D-1 category. No injury. Main Aerodrome.</p>

A large audience attended and thoroughly enjoyed this variety show. 	14 May 1943		<p>Clear to cloudy. R162179 LAC Ringer, J.A., while taxiing Harvard BW195 during night flying, turned onto the taxi strip too soon. Preceding aircraft had extinguished red lantern marking turning point. Aircraft struck a fire extinguisher, damaging propellor. C-1 category. No injury. Main Aerodrome.</p> <p>Course #73 held their Wings Parade at 1430 hours. Wings were presented by Group Captain Raymond, Commanding Officer of this Station. Two Squadrons, comprising one flight of airwomen, in addition to the graduating class were on parade. Rockcliffe and Uplands Bands participated.</p>
