Dear Mr. Sparkes:

I am sending you under separate cover the copy of my book, "Industry and Humanity", which you were kind enough to say you would accept.

I should like, in giving it to you, to express how much I feel I owe to your own work and the exceptionally able Memorandum prepared by you for the Whitley Committee. You will find throughout the book evidences of the influence of your thought and ideas. I regret that the specific reference to the Memorandum on Industrial Self-Government has not a more conspicuous place than that given it on page 477 of the book. Most of the volume was written, and some of it in the printer's hands, before I had ascertained and verified the particulars therein mentioned. I hope, however, that the form in which the reference appears may serve as at least one permanent record of the place which ought to be accorded your work in the great movement which has found expression in the Joint Standing Industrial Councils.
