To only a limited number of citizens is this appeal being sent; those who will appreciate the privilege of membership in the Council; and who recognize the desirability of informing the general public on important questions.


An invitation is extended to you to become a sustaining member of the Toronto Branch of the Council at a minimum annual fee or donation of \$10.

You will receive notices of all meetings and other programmes. Seats are reserved for sustaining members and their families at all of the Council's lectures.


However, let us make it clear that the chief purpose of a limited sustaining membership is to permit the Council's important work to be carried on for the benefit of the whole community.
