The Department desires to install fire escapes and a fire protection system at the Carcross Boarding School and I am enclosing herewith details of the fire escape to be fixed to the walls at the side of each monitor's room.

It is also desired to install a standpipe of light inch salvanized from for vertical lift about fowty feet in length added to the distance to well and connections with force pump, which should be connected with the tank and supplied with four light inch globe valves.

Three fifty foot lengths of 12 inch hose with couplings and noszels and also one fifty foot length with couplings for the roof only may be purchased. These articles may be bought from Mr. Matthew Watson, Caroffess, and the Department will rely upon you to make the best arrangement possible as to price.
