In reply to your letter dated February Elst, this Headquarters is not aware of any restrictions on the export of used aircraft to the United States but as in this case the aircraft was manufactured by the Gessna Aircraft Company, Wichita, Kansas, this Department would not be prepared to issue a Gertificate of Airworthiness for Export but would be prepared to state if so requested by the U.S. Sivil Aeronautics Authority that at some given date al-Ganadian Gertificate of Airworthiness was in force.

Since the Cessna Crane CF-BMM is a Ganadian registered aircraft, there would be no objection to a Ganadian pilot flying this aircraft into the United States subject to compliance with the usual Gustoms and Immigration requirements.
