

conferred by the directors of the branches in the manner aforesaid. And all members of the Corporation shall have membership of a branch.

Who are eligible for members.

ARTICLE 20.—All persons engaged in agriculture, who have attained the age of eighteen years, and of good moral character, are eligible for membership, provided they have resided for six months in the district previous to application. No member will be eligible for office unless he has attained the age of twenty-one years.

Withdrawal from Membership.

ARTICLE 21.—A member may withdraw from the Corporation by advising the secretary of the Corporation or of the Branch of which he is a member of his intention by registered letter. A member may be suspended by the Corporation or by his Branch as the case may be for non-payment of his dues if more than one year in arrears, or for conduct unbecoming to a member of this association, to be determined by two thirds of the votes of the directors of the branch to which he belongs, subject to an appeal to the central board whose decision shall be final. Such member shall have no recourse against the corporation.

Fees.

ARTICLE 22.—Membership fee shall be one dollar initiation fee, in addition one dollar
