

show of hands, the chairman having a casting vote ; except the admission of new members, provided for in Article 1 of Constitution.

Rule 4th.—All questions of order shall be decided by the chairman ; but any member present may appeal from his ruling, in which case the question shall be put without debate, "Shall the ruling of the chairman be sustained?" and decided in favor of the majority.

ARTICLE V.—COUNCIL OF THE SCHOOL OF ART.

This Society shall be represented on the Council of the School of Art by seven members, and the President and Vice-President, and four members present at a meeting shall form a quorum.

ARTICLE VI.—EXHIBITION.

The Annual Exhibition shall be held during the month of May, or as near that time as circumstances may permit.

The pictures shall be hung by a committee composed of members of the Society, whose award upon all points left to their decision shall be final, and who shall be guided by the following rules:—

1. All works exhibited must be original, and must be such as have not been previously exposed to public view in the City of Toronto, except in the artist's studio.

2. The Hanging Committee shall be elected at the April meeting.
