"private concerns, I am induced to give you that recess which I know you wish, but I cannot let you depart without expressing my earnest desire that you will individually endeavour to cultivate that spirit of Industry and obedience to the Laws amongst your Constituents and neighbours, which must ever precede and ensure prosperity; at the same time that I recommend, in the strongest terms, an attention to the interior quiet and good order of every part of the country where your influence may extend; which is at all times necessary to the general afety, but more particularly so at this very extraordinary and important criss.

" I do in AIS MAJESTY'S name Prorogue this General Affembly to Monday the Seventeenth day of June next; and the same is Proro-

" gued accordingly.
