



Therefore, there are special considerations which we urge a party-liner user to keep in mind :

1. Long conversations prevent the use of the line by the other subscriber: therefore partyline talks should be as brief as possible.


2. Whenever another party-line subscriber requests the use of the line for an emergency, courtesy should be prompt the first user temporarily to give up the use of the line

3. Whenever a party line subscriber takes the receiver from the hook and finds the line in use, the receiver should be replaced at once in a careful manner.

4. At the end of a conversation the receiver should be replaced upon the hork immediately, otherwise the other subscriber cannot signal the central office.

5. Be sure always to give the operator the lefters W or J in calling a party-line subscriber Co-operation is required to ensure good service of any kind.




