That they are musical is beyond a doubt. We had one young man with us, Mr. Lawrence Burton, who surpassed any of the white boys here in intellect, being both an orator and poet. He took part in the Great War, thereby losing his hearing. He did not live long

> after his return. One of our Members of Parliament, Mr. W. P. Telford, took a great interest in the B.M.E. Church and attended most of their concerts He, too, has passed away to the Better Land, though his influence is still with us.

> I doubt if th echurch would have held gotether as well as it has if it had not been for the kindly efforts put forth by a Mrs Straith, whom, I believe, represented them as a delegate in the Old Land two or three years ago. I am happy to say, she is still with us. Some time ago, she went to the west and organized a W.C.T.U. for the colored people, so you see she has their interests very much at heart, whether appreciated

When the choir here si in full membership it forms one of the most attractive features in Owen Sound, and the young men of the congregation handle stringed instruments in a most fascinating manner.

I must also make mention of the untiring efforts of Mr. Thomas Green, a colored man, who has been superintendent of the Sunday School for a number of years.

Now I have told you all the good qualities of them but next time I may tell you some of their bad ones such as everyone being addicted to coming to church late.
