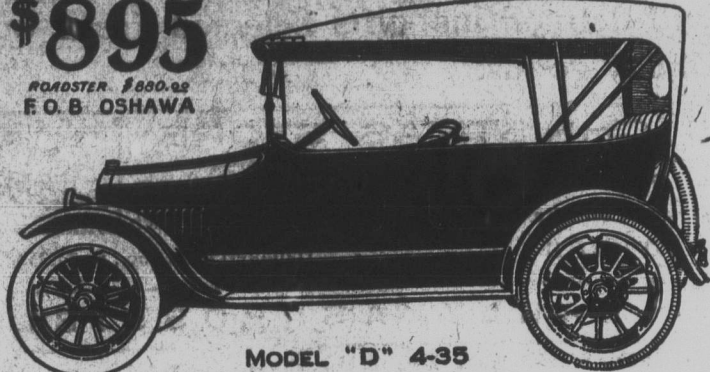

Take part 1, part 2, part 3 as one division. After having gone over the book apply for examination papers. Then take the rest of the book viz. parts 4 to 10, again apply for examination papers.

Tralle's work is not nearly so difficult, and is more up-to-date. It does not cover the same ground, but gives the teacher great help in his or her work.
