AMUSEMENTS SEEKS NEW CUSTOMS HOUSE FOR TORONTO T. L. Church Claims Present Customs Quarters Inadequate for Queen City. OTTAWA, May 30.—(By Canadian Press)—T. L. Church (Con., North Toronto) made a plea in the House of Commons today for a new customs house in Toronto. He said, however, no customhouse, but "we've got some dilapidated rented buildings" the construction of the buildings now occupied was growing intolerable. Business men were complaining all the time. He said that H. C. Hoeken (Con., West Toronto) declared that the customs department was occupying an old baking powder factory as examining warehouse, and Sir Henry Drayton observed that if the Canadian National Railways could afford to purchase a hotel in Paris and erect expensive quarters in Toronto, surely Toronto was entitled to a customhouse. Hon. Jacques Bureau, minister of customs, frankly admitted that present facilities in Toronto were inadequate. Until the country was in a position to pay the cost he could give no assurance that a new building would be erected.

Good, Progressive member for Brant, calling for a return showing the names and addresses of rural mail carriers, by province, was lost on a division in the House of Commons this afternoon. When the motion came up Hon. George F. Graham, acting postmaster-general, asked that it be not pressed. Mr. Good said he did not think the expense involved in getting out this list would be very great. However, as the Government refused, he would to abide by the decision. "Motion dropped," said the Speaker. "The motion is not dropped," said Mr. Good. "I said, Mr. Speaker, that if the Government declined to give me information I would have to accept its decision." The Speaker called for the Yeas and Nays and the resolution was voted down.
