Canadian correspondents will find postal notes convenient for small remittances, but where these cannot be readily obtained, 1/2c. and 1c. stamps will be accepted.

Correspondents in other British Colonies until further notice may remit in stamps to any amount. Sets (up to 3p., 6p. or 1s.) & new or provisional issues are preferred.

From Foreign Countries amounts under S1.00 only will be accepted in stamps.
