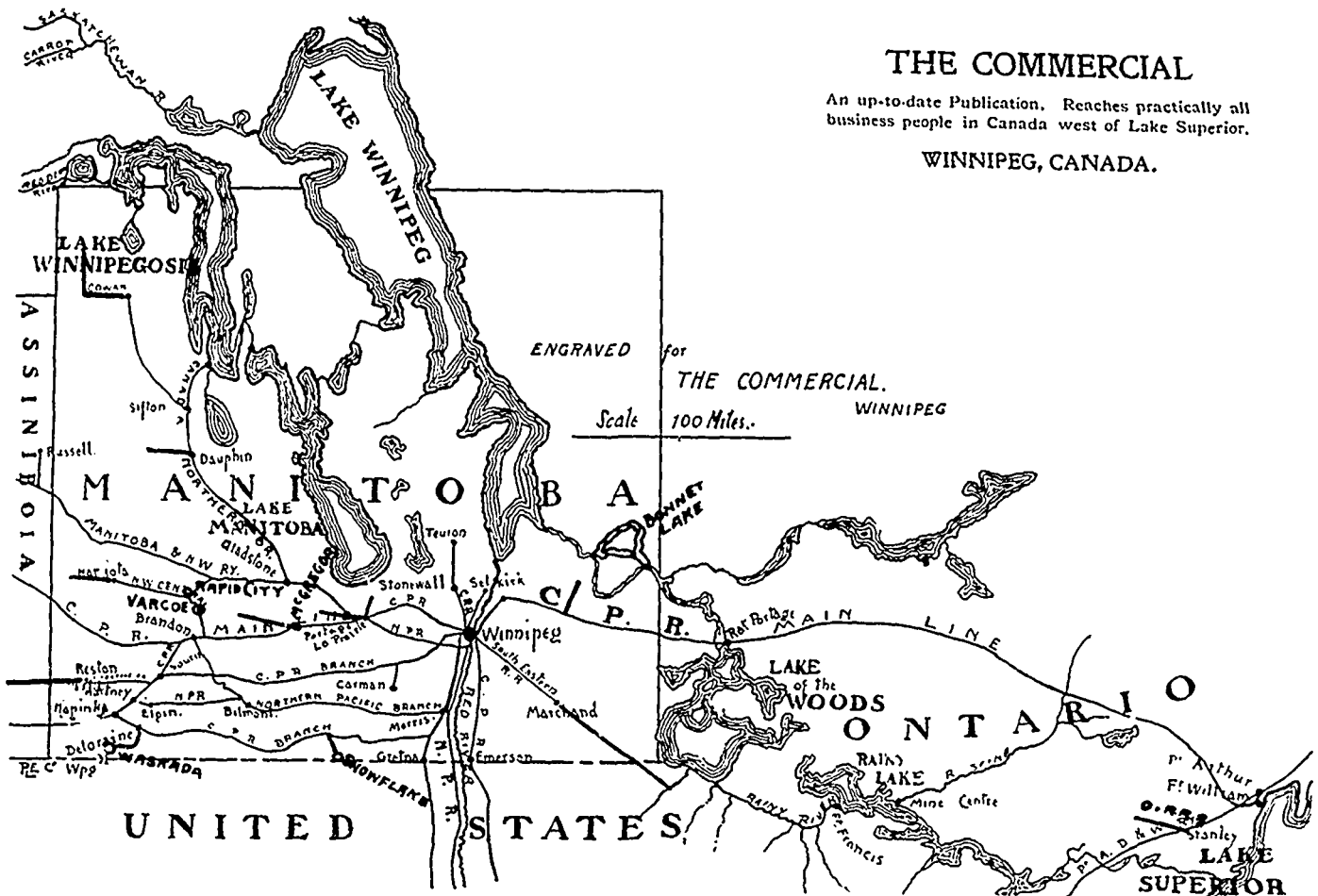

RAILWAY MAP OF MANITOBA AND NORTHWESTERN ONTARIO

New roads, built or under construction during 1899, with terminals or objective points, are shown in red. Following is the mileage of new road: Northern Pacific, lake branch, 9 miles; Portage branch extension, 20 miles. Canadian Northern, main line extension, 65 miles; Gilbert Plains branch, 15 miles. Manitoba Southeastern, 68 miles (partly in Minnesota). Canadian Pacific Railway, Snowflake branch, 17 miles; Wascada branch, 18 miles; Pipestone branch extension, 10 miles; McGregor-Vareoe branch, (graded only) 21 miles; Lac du Bonnet branch, (under construction) 10 miles. Northwest Central extension, 22 miles. Rapid City connecting link, 3 miles. Ontario and Rainy River, (under construction) 10 miles. Total, 351 miles.
