LETTER DATED 9 AUGUST 1989 ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE CONFERENCE ON DISARMAMENT BY THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CANADA TRANSMITTING A REPORT ISSUED AS ARMS CONTROL VERIFICATION PAPER NO. 3, ENTITLED "INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY SAFEGUARDS AS A MODEL FOR VERIFICATION OF A CHEMICAL WEAPONS CONVENTION" */

On 21-24 October 1988, the Strategic Studies Programme of the University of Calgary convened a workshop in Banff Springs, Alberta, Canada, on the subject of "International Atomic Energy Agency Safeguards as a Model for Verification of a Chemical Weapons Convention". The proceedings of this workshop, which involved the participation of several Canadian and international experts as well as representatives from the IAEA and of some delegations to the Conference on Disarmament, have now been published by the Arms Control and Disarmament Division of the Canadian Department of External Affairs.
