with or without weapon.

As to the Indictment and Verdict.

Attempting commit an indictable offence.

Using chloroform, &c., to commit any indictable oftence.

Maliciously inflict grievous bodily harm.

Maliciously person.

bodily injury grievous bodily harm upon any other person, either with or without any weapon or instrument, is guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be liable

to be imprisoned in the Penitentiary for any term not exceeding three years and not less than two years, or to be imprisoned in any other gaol or place of confinement for any term less than two years, with or 5 without hard labour : and if upon the trial of any indictment for any felony (except in cases of murder or manslaughter), the indictment alleges that the defendant did cut, stab, wound or inflict grievous bodily harm on any person, and the jury be satisfied that the defendant is guilty of the cutting, stabbing or wounding, or inflicting grievous bodily 10 harm, charged in the indictment, but be not satisfied that the defendant is guilty of the felony charged in such indictment, the jury may acquit of the felony, and find the defendant guilty of unlawfully cutting, stabbing or wounding, or inflicting grievous bodily harm, and such defendant shall be liable to be imprisoned in the Penitentiary for 15 any term not exceeding five years and not less than two years, or to be imprisoned in any gaol or place of confinement, other than the Penitentiary, for any term less than two years.

20. Whoseever by any means whatsoever attempts to choke, sufficient to choke, &c., or strangle any other person, or by any means calculated to choke, 20 in order to sufficient or strangle attempts to render any other person incompile suffocate or strangle, attempts to render any other person insensible, unconscious, or incapable of resistance, with intent in any of such cases thereby to enable himself or any other person to commit, or with intent in any of such cases thereby to assist any other person in committing any indictable offence, is guilty of felony, and shall be liable to 25 be imprisoned in the Penitentiary for life, or for any term not less than two years, or to be imprisoned in any other gaol or place of confinement for any term less than two years, with or without hard labour, and if a male with or without whipping.

> 21. Whosoever unlawfully applies or administers to, or causes to be 30 taken by, or attempts to apply or administer to, or attempts or causes to be administered to or taken by any person, any chloroform, laudanum, cr other stupifying or overpowering drug, matter or thing, with intent in any of such cases thereby to enable himself or any other person to commit, or with intent in any of such cases thereby to assist 35 any other person in committing any indictable offence, is guilty of felony, and shall be liable to be imprisoned in the Penitentiary for life, or for any other term not less than two years, or to be imprisoned in any other gaol or place of confinement for any term less than two years, with or without hard labour, and if a male with or without 40 whipping.

22. Whosoever unlawfully and maliciously administers to, or causes administering to be administered to or taken by any other person, any poison or other poison, &c., destructive or noxious thing, so as thereby to endanger the life of such badily danger life or person, or so as thereby to inflict upon such person any grievous bodily 45 harm, is guilty of felony, and shall be liable to be imprisoned in the Penitentiary for any term not exceeding ten years and not less than two years, or to be imprisoned in any other gaol or place of confinement for any term less than two years, with or without hard labour.

23. Whosoever unlawfully and maliciously administers to, or causes 50 administering to be administered to or taken by any other person, any poison or poison, &c., with intent to other destructive or noxious thing, with intent to injure, aggrieve, or injure, aggra. annoy such person, is guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be liable to be vate or annoy imprisoned in the Penitentiary for any term not exceeding three years, and not less than two years, or to be imprisoned in any other gaol or 55 place of confinement for any term less than two years, with or without hard labour.
