The Minister of Reconstruction and Supply—On Monday, April 25, next— IN COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE—The following Resolution:—

Resolved, That it is expedient to introduce a measure to encourage and assist in the construction of a Trans-Canada Highway and to provide for this purpose that the Minister of Reconstruction and Development may enter into agreements with any provinces providing for the payment by Canada to those provinces of contributions in respect of the cost of a Trans-Canada highway; with provision also for the employment of temporary engineers, technical officers and other employees for the purpose of the Act.
