At the last regular meeting of Corporation held on Wednesday the 11th October I read your letter of April 29th, 1933, in which you made the suggestion that Corporation grant representation on that body to the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research, the Library School and the School of Household Science, by electing a Graduate Fellow from each of these bodies.

After considerating, Corporation expressed the opinion that no useful purpose would be served by electing these additional members. Corporation has for some time felt that that body is quite large enough as at present constituted, and that it embodies within its present membership a fair cross section of graduate opinion.
