

ADDITIONAL RULES & OF POLICE for the City and OF MONTREAL

AT the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace held in the Court-House in the City of Montreal, on Saturday the tenth day of January one thousand eight hundred and twenty four, and continued by adjournment until the nineteenth day of the same month by virtue and under the authority of a Provincial Act, of the fifty seventh year of George the Third, Chap. 16, intitled "an Act to provide more effectually for the regulation of the Police, in the cities of Quebec and Montreal, and in the town of Three-Rivers, and for other purposes," It was ordered that the following Rules and Regulations of Police, be for the future in force and effect in the said City of Montreal, and that they be classed and numbered as follows.

Additional General Regulations. Chapter 1.

ARTICLE 61.—In all cases where, on the application of persons concerned at any special sessions of the Peace, it shall appear just and reasonable to the justices of the peace of this City, to deviate from that part of the fourth Article of the regulations of Police now in force, "which only allows the occupation of a space of eighteen feet in breadth of any public square, in front of lots contiguous thereto, for depositing building materials," the said Justices of the Peace may deviate therefrom and authorize the Surveyor of roads to permit such part of the said squares to be occupied by the said materials as the session shall have allowed and fixed in place and stead of the said eighteen feet.—And, in such case, the same precautions, formalities and obligations shall be observed as in the deposit permitted by the said fourth article, and under the penalties denounced by the same against the contraveners thereof.

ARTICLE 62.—In addition to the fifty eighth article of the Regulations of Police now in force, "which enjoins to the inhabitants of this city, and to the company of proprietors of the Water Works of Montreal, certain obligations therein specified, in opening any street, lane or public square in the city or suburbs for any purpose whatever, and fixes certain penalties for delinquents;" it is ordered that, for the future, every person who, by contract passed between him and three justices of the peace of this city, or between him and the surveyor of Roads of this city, or who by verbal agreement in presence of one or several witnesses or engagement under private signature between him and the said three Justices of the Peace or surveyor, shall undertake to open any of the said streets, lanes, or public squares, for the purpose of constructing drains or public sewers, or for any other cause whatever, shall be subject to the obligations imposed by the said fifty-eight article, and in default of conformity thereto, shall incur the penalties denounced by the same against every delinquent.
