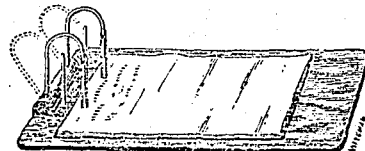

Mich., during last month were 7,882,981 feet.The second and last instalment of the French  
loan to the Quebec Government has been for-  
warded.R. L. CLEMENTS, of Yarmouth, N.S., crockery  
and silver ware dealer, has added an extensive  
boot and shoe department to his business.Two new locks, of huge dimensions and solid  
proportions are in course of construction on the  
American side at Saint St. Marie.The ship *Paul Boyton*, lately lost on Good-  
win Sands, was insured in Yarmouth, N.S.,  
offices for \$22,000. She was a fine vessel, 1057  
tons, owned by Andrew Lovitt and others.It is currently reported that Hon. James  
Paton has received the appointment to the  
long vacant position of Collector at Toronto.  
The report, at time of writing, however, lacks  
official confirmation.Geo. N. Main, carpenter and builder, Yar-  
mouth, N.S., has left for the United States, leav-  
ing property attached by his creditors. Liabili-  
ties about \$3,000. Unincumbered assets about  
\$1,000.
