

To Reach the Association.

Take any of the following cars:

College and Yonge St., Bloor and McCaul, or Carlton and College. All other lines will give transfers to one of the above. The fare is 5c. (2½d), for any distance, but tickets can be purchased from the conductors at the rate of six for 25c. (1 shilling).

How to Reach Toronto.

1. European Visitors.

(a) *Present certificates of E. C. P. A., countersigned by the Secretary of the British Medical Association, or Honorary Local Secretary, at place of landing, and buy a ticket to Toronto at a cost of one-half the lowest one way first-class fare and KEEP THE CERTIFICATE FOR FURTHER USE.* (These certificates may be obtained from the General Secretary, Guy Elliston, 429 Strand, London, W.C., or from the Honorary Local Secretaries, Medical Building, Queen's Park, Toronto).

(b) This rate is good till September 30th, 1906, from July 1st.

(c) Side trips may be taken from Toronto to all points in the Territory of the Eastern Canadian Passenger Association, including trips to the Maritime Provinces (see British Medical Journal, May 26th, 1906). To Banff and Vancouver (The return may be via the Northern Pacific, visiting Yellowstone Park), or such shorter trips as The Thousand Islands and the Saguenay, Algonquin National Park, Niagara Falls, Hamilton, Barrie and Lakes Simcoe and Couchiching, Muskoka Lakes, Georgian Bay, Lake of Bays, Temagami, etc., and the Capital of the Dominion, Ottawa.

2. American Visitors.

Obtain certificate from the Railway Agent at starting point and pay full going fare to Toronto. This certificate upon being validated in Toronto will entitle the holder to return by the same way as he came for one-third of the rate which he paid on the coming journey, if by the lines of the Trunk Line Association and Central Passenger Association, or to a free return if by the lines of the New England Passenger Association.

Read particulars given below with care.

3. Canadian Visitors.

Obtain certificate from the Railway Agent at the starting point and pay full going fare to Toronto. This certificate on being validated at Toronto will entitle the holder to return by the same way as he came without further payment.
