Duties of Scouts.—All entrance moneys shall be held by the Scouts representing the Alliance on the grounds. He shall divide the purses, retaining the percentages. He shall mark with ink on the handicap card of the winners the date and the temporary handicap for the day, and shall make a record thereof in his daily minute book.

He shall take charge of the score books at night during a tournament.

He shall have authority to employ such subordinates as he may require.

He shall countersign the handicap cards. He shall have authority to change the permanent handicap cards of unknown members.

He shall sell the "Target Cards" and redeem any unused parts thereof.

ARTICLE XIII.

Matches Per Telegraph.

Teams or individuals may arrange matches, or the Alliance may arrange same, to be shot by each at their own respective localities, without coming together, upon complying with the following conditions, viz:

The entrance fee shall be sent by mail to the Secretary of the Alliance, to reach him before the shooting begins. If the entrance fee is not sent by mail it may be sent by telegraph one hour before the shooting be-
