VINDICATED TOO LATE

Hostile Vestry Locked Out Rector Who Died Before Court Upheld Him.

NEW YORK, March 27.—Vindicated too late by the courts, the Rev. William Nicholas Ackley, rector of St. Andrew's Protestant Episcopal Church in South Brooklyn, died at the rectory this morning only a few hours before Justice Marean, in the state supreme court, rendered a decision upholding him in his fight against a hostile vestry.

Twice within the past nine months the board of vestrymen, demanding that Mr. Ackley resign, locked him out of his church, and he was compelled to preach out doors to those of his congregation still loyal, from the church steps. He protested to Bishop Burgess, who upheld his right to the pulpit, but the contention preyed on his mind and undermined his health, and to-day he died—his friends say of a broken heart.
