NAPLES AND SAN FRANCISCO

Berlin, April 20.—Prof. Matteucci, director of the royal observatory on Mount Vesuvius, answering an enquiry of the Lokal Anzeiger telegraphs that the eruption of Mount Vesuvius and the California earthquake supply confirmation of the general belief that volcanoes and earthquakes are diverse effects of one cause.

Lawyer May Yet Explain.

The case of Christopher Holland is going to prove of much interest. Judging from remarks of Crown-Attorney Curry and of T. C. Robinson, counsel for the defence, the solicitor to the Ideal Bedding Co. has gone pretty near the limit. The issuing of the warrant in the first place, it is hinted, was nothing but a bluff to frighten Holland by holding this thing over his head, not intending to insist that the warrant be executed.

When Holland was arraigned before Magistrate Denison yesterday Crown Attorney Curry drew the magistrate's attention to a letter written by Solicitor Levesconte, and also to the deposition made by Holland and his solicitor to the effect that the Toronto lawyer had made an effort to bleed Holland. In the absence of Levesconte further proceedings were adjourned.

Ottawa Teamsters May Strike.  
Ottawa, April 20.—The teamsters of the Dominion Transport Co., which handles C.P.R. freight, and the Shedd Company, which handles G.T.R. freight, have demanded an increase in wages, and unless it is forthcoming Saturday night there will be a strike. The men average 12 hours a day, and draw \$37 a month, and want \$45.
