ENDOWMENT OF PARISHES.

For this fund the Sub-Committee have received during 1863 \$2468.35, partly in trust and partly to accumulate for the benefit of the Parishes. A particular statement will be found as usual in the Appendix.

At the recommendation of the Endowment Committee, a rule was adopted which allows any parish to withdraw its money, when amounting to \$1,000, from the "reserved Fourths," and to deposit the sum with the Society *in Trust*, with the Interest payable annually to the Incumbent. The Sub-Committee now hold Securities for about \$13,040 belonging to this fund. Since its formation in
