Re: Parry Island Timber

Receipt is acknowledged of your letter of October 2nd. A permit may be issued to Elijah Tabobandung to cut timber to be used for building or in exchange for building material. The quantity should be limited to 300 logs.

If the timber is used for the purposes authorized, it may be cut free of dues. Should any of the timber be sold, dues should be collected at \$10.50 per M for pine and \$5.00 for hemlock.
