BAPTISTS DECLARE FOR DOMINION CONVENTION

Unanimous Vote Favors It at Western Baptist Convention in Winnipeg—Former Maritime Province Men Take Important Part in Proceedings.

(Winnipeg Free Press, July 7.) After devotional exercises the Baptist convention yesterday afternoon, conducted by Rev. B. K. Morse, B. A., of Pilot Mound; Rev. J. B. Warwick, first vice president, was called upon to take the chair. Rev. D. R. Harkness introduced the idea of a Dominion convention. He stated that over 60 letters had been sent out and about thirty answers received, as to the attitude to be taken towards a Dominion convention, all of these being favorable. W. A. McIntyre introduced the discussion. He recalled the first bringing up of the question ten years ago, again at the convention, and then two years ago at Portage in Prairie, where a resolution had been passed which he read, arguing that the church is above provincialism, as a far-reaching national policy is far better than local exclusiveness and separatism. In introducing the result of the deliberations of a committee he outlined the project as providing for general supervision while preserving the autonomy and independence of the provincial conventions. Mr. McIntyre enumerated the following advantages which would result from the scheme, a broader outlook, the sense of strength which comes from unity, national information conveyed by a national paper. The scheme would never interfere with the independence of the convention, as the power will always come from the people. The scheme would mean union in foreign mission work, a panoramic view in home missions, the whole evangelization, girls pouring into a large scheme in church edifice work, which would not be given for a small one; it would mean a national newspaper and publication house, issuing national Sunday school papers. With regard to education Mr. McIntyre had a great deal to say by setting out the needs of the people, with a university at the top, the nucleus of which is at Brandon today, and a national university including McMaster at Toronto, which is second to none in the universities of Acadia, and that at Brandon; this movement.
