BRITISH MERCHANT SEAFARERS WHO ARE INTERESTED IN GERMANY
So soon as British merchant seafarers were interested in Germany the Imperial Merchant Service Guild set special inquiries on foot to ascertain what particular captains and officers of merchant ships had been placed in captivity. Reliable information was difficult to obtain for some time, but after constant inquiry the Guild has been able to prepare a complete list of those members of the nautical profession who are interested. A copy of this list has been addressed to the British Board of Trade and to the Prisoners of War Help Committee. The Guild has been in constant touch with the interested captains and officers and their relatives and dependants in Great Britain and in respect to both are, in many cases, making special financial provision out of the Guild war fund. At the same time they are periodically sending parcels of provisions, tobacco, cigarettes and the like to each merchant captain and officer interned in Germany.
