

—Paroles for nineteen inmates of the Kalapaupau leprosarium on the islands of Molokai, some of whom have been confined to the settlement for more than twenty years, have been recomcended by the Territorial Board of Health as the consequence of the successful results that have attended their treatment with chaulmoogra oil specific, evolved by Dr. A. L. Dean, president of the University of Hawaii.

The latest paroles, to sixteen men and three women, brings to nearly 200 the number of persons who have been treated in Hawaii since 1919, when the specific was discovered, according to a health board announcement.

Persons released on parole are not considered to be cured, but the examining physicians believe the disease has been checked in their cases sufficiently to permit them to mingle with other persons without danger.


