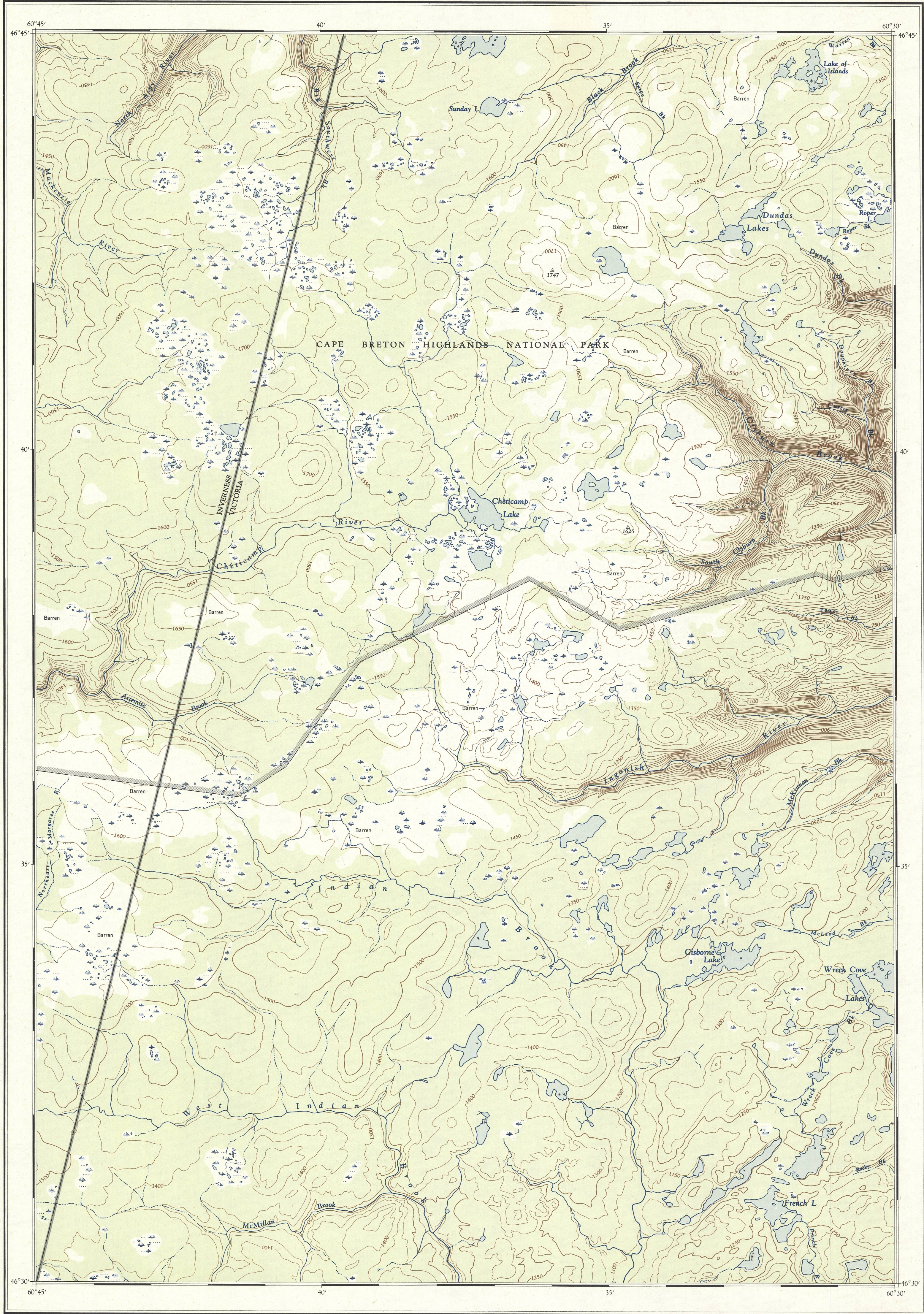


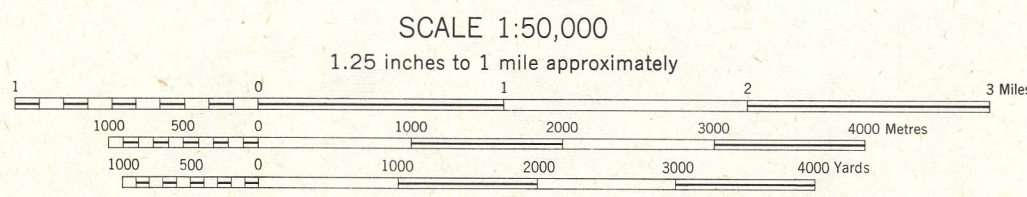

Annual magnetic change 2" easterly

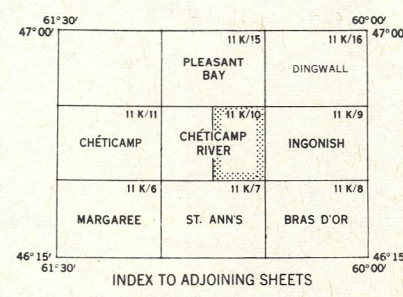
