FISH BOUNTIES.

In the course of his Committee report of Her Majesty's Dominions, Prince Edward's Island, there has been found within certain limits of the Legislature to foster and protect the most lucrative of their resources, their Fisheries. One of their latest acts of Assembly provides that 12s. 6d. per ton shall be given to all persons who shall own and equip vessels from the Island for the Fisheries. The voyage to be not less than three months—during which time she is to earn no freight. We understand also that a vessel is engaged in the protection of their fisheries in British waters, a most necessary precaution. Here then we find a due regard paid to the employment of the people, and a dignified protection provided against the shameful invasions of our western neighbours. How strange the case was when it was proposed to give to the fisheries a good deal of complaint has been made by our Fishermen—a good deal of Legislation has been had on the subject for many successive seasons; and how we would ask here we profited by all this action? Why in the first place there has been passed a Law annulling the trade of herring fishing, so far as the jurisdiction of this Province extends. The law forbidding the taking of the full grown fish with nets, during the "spawning season" which season is the whole summer, the only time that Herrings are to be found on the coast. Hence then, when fish are to be had, it is unlawful to fish for them, and when it is permitted to fish for them, they are to be taken in a manner which is entirely useless for food, are allowed to rot in the sea, and the fish are to be sold for nothing. Another feature of the improvement, which has cost the country so much money is this, that the only vessel provided by the province for the protection of the fisheries of the Bay of Fundy has been removed, and is now stationed in the Gulf of St. Lawrence, while the sloop of war, that was on the station, has been ordered to the West Indies, thus leaving a clear space for all American "poachers" who may feel disposed to molest the fish in British waters. During the last session of Parliament, in order to show the constituency that something was intended for the benefit of the fisheries, a grant was made to His Excellency for the encouragement of the fisheries, that grant amounts to something less than a nully, as the sum is so small and the conditions so large, before anything can be obtained that no sane man will be found to invest himself in so silly an undertaking. It was truly said by an American, who speaking of annexation, and the advantages to be derived therefrom to the United States, that if the whole United States were searched for persons to fill our Assembly and to legislate for their interest, he believed it could not be so completely effected as it now is by our own Representatives. We do hope and trust, that before another session of the House, that the operative fishermen will be consulted, and that steps beneficial to their interest, and creditable to the country will be permanently adopted.
