Shown above are the first photographs of the fall of Tampico. The photographs were taken on May 13, when, after five days of fighting, the constitutionalists, under General Pablo Gonzales and General Luis Caballero, with 7,000 men, entered the city as the federalists abandoned it, leaving many wounded behind. The fighting was the most severe in the present revolution, and many were killed and wounded on both sides. Casualties were as great as during the fighting which occurred previous to the defeat of the federalists by General Francisco Villa at Torreon. The photographs were taken by John T. Meacham, the New York Herald's and this paper's special correspondent and photographer at Tampico. The picture in the upper right hand corner shows the constitutionalist cavalry crossing the bridge between Plaza de Libertad and the Custom House just after General Gonzales and the rebel army had occupied the city.
