NO TRACE YET OF CANADIAN CHALLENGE CUP

New York, Oct. 19.—In a cable message to the National Horse Show Association, Lord Decies announced that he has failed in all efforts to end the Canadian Challenge Cup, an international trophy for army officers, which was won at the last National Horse Show by Lieut. Baron De Melow of France. Army Captain Merwin Crawshaw, of the British army, won the cup in 1912 and took it home with him to be turned over to the next winner. Crawshaw has been killed in action and nothing can be feared of Baron De Melow, except that he will lead the front with his regiment, the First Cruisers, at the outbreak of the war.
