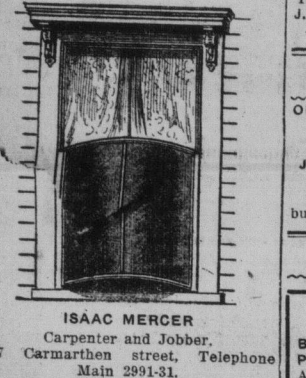

REARRANGEMENT OF
MINTO COAL PRICE
E. Lorne Merrithew Returns
From Ottawa, Where He
Had Satisfactory Interview
With Hon. Mr. Carvell and
Others.

Fredericton, July 19.—E. Lorne Mer-
rithew, who was one of the delegation
of the smaller operators of the Grand
Lakes coal district which went to Ot-
tawa to protest concerning the prices
at the mine proposed for New Brun-
swick by Fuel Controller McGrath, re-
turned to Fredericton today. He states
that the delegates had a conference
with Capt. McGrath, son of the fuel
controller, who is adviser to his father.
They also had the opportunity of in-
terviewing Hon. F. B. Carvell. The fuel
controller himself was at Washington.
Assurances were given the delega-
tion that a rearrangement in the mat-
ter of price for Minto coal would be
made as the result of representations
made by the delegates. He believes
that it will be satisfactory to the mine
operators. Fuel Controller McGrath
was to consider the matter upon his
return from Washington.
